

Alexander Soucek

Alexander Soucek is the Head of the Public International Law Division of the European Space Agency (ESA). He also serves as the Secretary of the International Space Station Coordination Committee and the legal advisor of ESA's International Relations Committee, and represents ESA in the Legal Subcommittee of the UN COPUOS.

He earned degrees in law from Salzburg University, Austria, and in space studies from the International Space University in Strasbourg, France. He is an alumnus of the Hague Academy of International Law Centre for Studies and Research, a former visiting researcher at the Space Policy Institute, George Washington University, and a former research assistant in international law at Salzburg University.

He lectures on space law and the law of international organisations and published books, commentaries and articles on space law. He is a corresponding member of the International Academy of Astronautics, a member of the International Institute of Space Law and of the European Centre for Space Law, and serves as a Director of the World Space Week Association. From 2003-2020, he also served as a member of the Executive Board, and president of the Austrian Space Forum.
