Memorandum of Understanding on Establishing

China-Nordic Law Center

BETWEEN

(1) East China University of Political Science and Law, (hereinafter referred to as "ECUPL");

AND

(2) University of Oslo, (hereinafter referred to as "UiO");

Who shall hereinafter together be referred to as the "Parties" or in the singular the "Party"

BACKGROUND

Following the ongoing collaboration between both Parties and the opportunity to further the cooperation on China-Nordic academic research, the Parties have agreed to jointly set up a research center to focus on the mutually interested issues. Therefore, the parties have decided to sign this MoU and cooperate as follows:

1. Functions and Vision of the Institution

The parties agree to set up a center, the China-Nordic Law Center (CNLC). CNLC is an open, academic and international platform to facilitate joint research on law and other relevant disciplines.

2 Co-directors

Each Party agrees to appoint a representative to co-ordinate and lead all the activities and initiatives of CNLC (the Academic Director/s).

3. Arrangements for the Center

CNLC will organize and advance interdisciplinary research on mutually interested issues. Both Parties agree to take turns to host academic conferences in China and Nordic respectively.

4. Dispute Resolution

Should there be any misunderstanding of the content of this MoU, the matter will be resolved based on mutual negotiation by two Parities.

5. Term of Application

This MoU is valid for five years from the date of signature. Both Parties can renew the MoU to continue their collaboration subject to their mutual consent.
