

Memorandum of Understanding

between

Peking University Law School

and

University of Oslo, Faculty of Law

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to further develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the Law Schools. Peking University Law School and University of Oslo, Faculty of Law, hereinafter referred to collectively as Parties, further agree as follows:

1. Both Parties agree and shall endeavor to promote collaborative activities in academic areas of mutual interest on a basis of equality and reciprocity. The activities shall include but not be limited to the following:

- exchange of faculty and students
- exchange of academic information and materials
- research collaboration including joint publications
- joint seminars, conferences and workshops
- other forms of academic cooperation

2. Terms of the specific areas of cooperation mentioned above shall be further considered and agreed upon in writing by both Parties prior to the initiation of any particular activity. Any specific activity will be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and other resources, and approval of both Parties.

3. This MoU is considered legally non-binding. The MoU shall be executed by both parties in good faith.

4. The Memorandum of Understanding is valid for 5 (five) academic years. This MoU may be amended only by written consent of both Parties. This MoU may be further extended by written consent of both Parties for a further specified period.

5. This MoU may be terminated by giving six months prior written notice. All collaborative activities already in the implementation phase shall be concluded as planned.

6. This MoU has been made in two identical copies in English, one for each Party.
