Birgit Feldtmann is a professor (mso) in *criminal law, criminal procedure and international law enforcement* at the Department of Law, Aalborg University. Her professional expertise is in particular on the inter-play between criminal law/criminal justice, human rights and international law with special focus on cross-border and international law enforcement, including law enforcement at sea. She is currently Head of the cross-disciplinary DFF2-research project “*Policing at Sea (PoISEA)*” under the Independent Research Council of Denmark (*Danmarks Frie Forskningsfond*). Since 2013, she has been involved in the work of the *Contact Group on Piracy off the Coast of Somalia (CGPCS)* as a legal expert and is a pro-bono technical expert with DIGNITY – Danish Institute against Torture.
