She is part of the PoISEA research project (Policing at Sea) funded by the Danish Independent Research Fund (Danmarks Frie Forskningsfond). Fenella's area of expertise is researching migration and the Law of the Sea. She is also examining the principle of mutual trust in international cooperation under EU law.
