Cincinnati, Ohio – ProDiálogo, a non-profit conflict transformation organization in Peru, will be the recipient of the 2014 International Outstanding Leadership Award from the Association for Conflict Resolution (ACR) International Section. The awardee was selected in recognition of their extraordinary contributions to intercultural dialogue, human rights and development in conflict contexts. The awards will be presented on October 8th, 2014 at ACR's Annual Conference in Cincinnati, Ohio.

ProDiálogo is a Peruvian non-profit organization that aims to contribute to sustainable development of its country through dialogue and peace. Founded in 2002, this institution has developed projects for several target populations, including children, women and urban teenagers at risk, and has been involved in different conflict scenarios throughout Peru, playing the role of an impartial third party between businesses, public institutions, civil society organizations, and Andean or Amazonian communities. Aware that the mismanagement of conflict is an obstacle to sustainable development, ProDiálogo facilitated processes of multi-stakeholder intercultural dialogue for conflict prevention and transformation around environmental and social issues. The success in this difficult and complex field has won them a level of recognition that enabled them to form alliances locally, nationally and internationally, expanding their reach in building cultures of peace throughout Peru.
